BONUS WORKSHOP - 1:30pm before Friday Freedom

**“Worship as a Weapon of Warfare” (Pat Forest)** – When we worship, we come into the presence of God. When in His presence, nothing can touch us. Worship takes on many forms and is a nuclear weapon against the enemy!

TABLE TOPICS - 4:00pm Friday

**“Keeping Your Home Spiritually Safe” (Judy Roberts)** – This is an effort to examine the spiritual safety of our personal environments. Do our homes truly reflect our Christian beliefs? We want to check our hearts and see if they are still sensitive and able to discern what is safe to partake from the culture in which we live.

**“Forgiveness” (Judy Emery)** – We all struggle with unforgiveness because LIFE HAPPENS! We are told to forgive as He has forgiven us. Is this possible? Many of us think NO but God says YES! Discovering the truths about this most valuable gift will vastly enable you to experience it.

**“Youth Ministry Ideas” (Melissa Hall)** – Today’s young people look at life in completely different ways than we did. They have different external pressures and temptations. This discussion will help you connect with them and minister to them in ways they will understand.

**“Blooming in the Winter Seasons of Life” (Donna Butler)** – Have you ever been at a time in your life where you felt like you were in the deepest, darkest, coldest desolation you could imagine? **“Breaking Agreements” (Amy George)** – Breaking agreement with old contracts made with the enemy can lead to victorious living. Discussion includes false beliefs, bad habits, and wrong-thinking that can hinder your spiritual growth. Also learn what you *should* come into agreement with.
